Camp Orchard Hill is pleased to provide you with transportation services to Day Camp!

As with all our programs your child's safety is most important to us. We will have a Camp Orchard Hill counselor on each van or bus to check your camper in and out and to supervise the children while coming to and from camp. If you need to send communication, payment or medication to the office, please provide it to the bus check-in team in a sealed envelope/ziploc bag with your child's name on it.

Please contact the office directly at office@camporchardhill.com or (570) 333-4098 x100 if you need to pick up your child in afternoon carline on any given day. We will communicate the change and have your child remain in the pick up line instead of on the bus!

In regard to illness – It's our priority to provide a healthy and safe experience for all of our campers and staff. We believe the best way to keep our community safe is to focus on prevention. Please evaluate your camper's health before they leave the house each morning. In addition, you can expect a short health screening including temperature check at bus check in. Please remain at home if you experience any of the following symptoms:

- A fever of 100.4 or greater, chills, sore throat, cough, common cold symptoms like runny nose and head congestion or nausea and diarrhea.
- Please instruct your camper to notify their counselor and the nurse right away if they experience these symptoms while at camp.
- We continue to monitor CDC and PA Dept. of Health guidelines for summer camps and will update accordingly.

In order to give your child the safest and most efficient ride to camp we have designated centrally located stops for pick-up and drop-off. Pick up locations and times are subject to change based on enrollment.

For everyone's safety we have the following rules for the bus. Please discuss these with your child.

1. Parents are responsible to wait with their child for the bus and get their child on and off the bus. Please look for a Camp Orchard Hill lettering on the side of the bus. Sign your child in and out with the bus counselor each day.
2. Campers need to listen and obey the bus counselor and driver.
3. Campers need to remain seated and once seated, do not change seats.
4. Tell your counselor if you have any problems on the bus.
5. Do not leave your seat to get off the bus until the vehicle has come to a complete stop.
6. Campers may use electronic devices while on their bus ride. When the bus arrives at camp, devices will be placed in the designated bus bin and stored in a safe location at camp during the day. Each parent is responsible to approve appropriate content and campers are responsible to select approved content. Each camper should play with his or her own device.

The bus or van will wait at each designated stop until the scheduled departure time, and then the bus must continue on its route.

Any changes in the transportation schedule prior to the start of camp or the camp week will be communicated via email. In the case of an emergency that would affect camper pick up or drop off time and location, we will contact you via text messaging and/or phone call.
